

Landscape Committee report

9 October 2013

The committee has been collaborating with Tru Green to produce a calendar of the services by week, by seasonal pruning cycles and annual tree pruning cycles. Maps representing these levels of maintenance have also been distributed.

A map indicating specific properties exempt from services is being distributed among the crew supervisors.

Some swales in the new area need additional clearing, but apparently caused no problems during the recent extreme rain storm.

Five landscape requests have been received since September 11. The damage incurred by one owner is in the process of being reconciled.

Along Country Club Drive and 49th Street a mugo pine is to be removed, azaleas cut back severely to stimulate new growth, some trees limbed up.

It is suggested that when the new irrigation system is installed that the St. John's Wort be replaced with turf to make a more uniform and tended appearance for the Village and provide simpler maintenance.
