Tree Pruning: You may have noticed that the City of Corvallis has recently hired an arborist to prune street trees in Stoneybrook.

Preparedness Tip of the Month - How to Make an Evacuation Kit: Get a sports bag and keep a change of clothes, extra shoes, personal hygiene items, at least a week of your medications, money, critical documents such as your bank account numbers, important phone numbers and identification and whatever else you would want should you need to evacuate your home in a hurry from fire or disaster. You should rotate the medications and whatever other items you want to in order to keep them fresh.

Landscape Updates: Here are a few infrequent landscape activities that are scheduled to happen in the months of April and May.

- Lawn moss, crane fly, broadleaf weed killer application: Between April 1-15th
- Lawn fertilizer application: Between April 1-15th
- Shrub fertilizer application: During month of April to be timed with the blooming of the rhododendrons
- 2nd lawn fertilizer application: Between May 15-30th

Spring/Summer shrub pruning will begin May 1st and start the 6 week pruning rotation.

Clubhouse Thermostat Installed: The new clubhouse thermostat is installed. In addition, doors will be unlocked during reservation hours so that guests can get in and out without the use of a card key. As temperatures have warmed, the heating has been turned off and the air conditioning has been turned on. The A/C is set to turn on at 75 degrees. However, if you wish to cool down the room a bit more, you may press the down arrows next to the "set to" words on the thermostat. This will hold your temperature settings until the regular schedule continues at 3:00pm or 10:00pm.
