

## Landscape Committee Board Report

August 10, 2016

The Landscape Committee continues to work on a design plan for the demonstration plot and is obtaining prices for native trees and shrubs. A fall planting after the weather has moderated is planned.

NLS is working on "catch up" pruning. They are now saying they will be caught up in two to three weeks. The committee is recommending withholding payment until they have caught up. They have also failed to mow and weed tract K and we have again discussed lack of service to this area with their representatives.

The irrigation project is coming along and we are extremely pleased with the quality of work by B. Johnson Turf. They have now reached the corner of Country Club and 49<sup>th</sup>st. The final portion is along 49<sup>th</sup> to Birdsong.

City arborists trimmed branches in street trees along 49<sup>th</sup> between Birdsong and Country Club yesterday. While they removed large branches, numerous smaller branches were left on both sides of the park strip. These will need to be raked out if we hope to mow the St. Johns Wort.
