

Landscape Committee met with NLS and Management on February 8. NLS marked many invasive plants, weeds and “sports” for removal along 49th Street and Country Club Drive.

Pruning, raking and cleaning of shrub beds within the Village are nearly complete. In some cases it is noted that some pruning was done in Opt-Out properties. Pruning, raking and cleaning of exterior shrub beds are to be completed by the end of February. New this year: Rhododendrons are being hand clipped.

Liquid iron (moss)/insecticide (cranefly) has been applied.

Agreement is established with the Owner at 4691H for removal of junipers along her West wall.

The Committee is not aware of new or pending requests from Owners *via* green forms.

Irrigation issues remain to be addressed in several locations: **1)** Several points along Country Club Drive East of the bus stop; **2)** Tract A; **3)** Tracts F,K; **4)** 4884H; **5)** 4691H shall be corrected with juniper removal.
