

The committee met with Will Ward and Edgar on May 27 to discuss current landscape services.

Landscape Committee met with representatives of the Board and ARC and Paul Barkley. Concerns about drainage in the vicinity of the Native Vegetation Demonstration Plot were addressed, issues clarified, and matters settled. Work on the Plot may recommence.

Native Vegetation Demonstration Plot: The plot has been weeded, final plantings are in place, and the area is prepared for delivery of bark mulch May 27.

Country Club Drive shrub replacements: Thirty plants, all native species, have been planted among existing laurels and mugho pines in the embankment between the Pond and 49th Street. These plants have an interesting variety of foliage with a succession of blooming and fruiting times to appeal to birds and bees. A diagram is posted on the bulletin board in the Conference Room at the Club House.

We are indebted to Keith Rasmussen and to Dick Miller's family for their assistance with both projects on Saturday, May 6. All that work was accomplished in just one day!

The committee still is dealing with Tracts F2, K3 and C1.

Conditions of curbside turf areas and streetside tree wells have been inventoried. The committee is developing a menu of options for treatments.
