

POND REPORT NOVEMBER 2020

Walk around with Tony Livermore, Supervisor, GAIA Landscapes, Inc.

Tuesday, October 27, 2020, Tony and I reviewed our ponds and surrounding landscaping for which they are responsible under contract. We reviewed all aspects of the contract and observed the following:

- SVOA Ponds. GAIA's careful attention to our pond eco-culture has resulted in our detention ponds and their surroundings exhibiting health and vibrant eco-culture.





- SVOA Landscaping around ponds. Performed bi-weekly.
 - Lawn Service – edging,weeding, and applications. GAIAhas applied pre-emergents (crabgrass, moss and weed control) in January and the spring applied crabgrass pre-emergents, organic fertilizers as required in the summer. As a result, our lawns and surroundings landscaping flourish.

- Shrubs & Beds Service – weeds are under control; shrubs and trees are growing and will be pruned and shaped.
- GAIA completed thatching and aerating and reseeding where necessary.

- GAIA has pruned bushes and trees along the pond (pond residents and the ponds) including this fellow who received a more extensive haircut this month.



- GAIA added a yellow dogwood to our north pond border plantings

- GAIA will implement the findings of its irrigation audit by replacing the irrigation along the south pond lawn area with drip irrigation.
- GAIA submitted its 2021 Contract for Stoneybrook Detention Ponds, Adjacent Landscape Beds and Lawns, and West Easement – no change in contract price from 2020 (\$11,469.00).
