SVOA has also been notified that a new manager will be taking over the TruGreen landscape management contract. In addition, a short-term Landscape Contract Committee is working on our needs for next year’s contract. Be on the lookout for a survey to assess our community’s landscape priorities that will be sent to you soon.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

A committee has been formed chaired by long-term residents Lois and Jim Palemo and is working on making our guiding regulations more assessable.
