

EMERGENCY TIP OF THE MONTH

Maintain a disaster preparedness kit for your pets.

Here are some things to consider including:

- When planning for water, include how much your pet needs
- Leashes, favorite treats and food, etc.
- Document your name and your pets names: a photograph of you and your pet helps
- Pet first aid kit, including any special medications
- Veterinarian contact info, and a brief health history of your pet
- Include a written medical release authorizing treatment for your pet if you are not available
- Identify neighbors that may be willing to house your pet in an emergency (the Preparedness Committee can provide some names if you need them)
- Include plenty of plastic waste bags
- Pet carriers are a good idea.
