Do You Want to Make Any Changes to Your SVOA Directory Listing? Mobile Phone Listing Now Available

Sign up for emergency alerts - What is the Alert System?

Linn-Benton ALERT is an emergency notification system that calls for messages to Linn and Benton County residents to warn of impending or occurring emergencies, evacuations and other urgent events (windstorms, snowstorms, earthquakes, etc.). It provides critical safety instructions when they are needed most. The system is address-based. It will send alerts to landline or cellular telephones (or the device of your choosing) in the zip code or neighborhood of areas affected by the emergency. By signing up, you will receive time-sensitive emergency and safety alerts from public safety officials. If you receive a call, you will hear a computer-generated message, but please do not hang up. Instead, listen to the message in its entirety for important information.
