### LINN-BENTON EMERGENCY ALERT SYSTEM

A reverse 911 call is a call initiated by emergency service to registered telephone numbers, for example to announce a mandatory evacuation. Interested owners who want to register their home phone number or ce3ll phone nu8mber may sign up for the Linn-Be3nton Alert system. It's similar to "reverse 911" and users can receive notifications about disasters or public safety issues in their neighborhoods. Participants can receive messages on landline phones, cell phones, multiple contact numbers or via text message and email. You just sign up and then mark your contact preferences and provide contact information. The service is free of charge and individuals can sign up to receive alerts related to the neighborhoods of themselves, other properties they own or loved ones. #### NORTHWEST LANDSCAPING SERVICES (NLS) SCHEDULE FOR MARCH AND APRIL

Mowing will occur after some dry weather arrives

Last week of February
Hard edge
First week of March
Complete bed grooming
Pre emergent weed control will be put down following the grooming
Moss/ Crane fly application
Early April
Broadleaf weed control and crab grass control application
Liquid fertilizer

Northwest Landscape Services (NLS) will begin backflow testing in the Stoneybrook Village community on 2-24-16. During the following two weeks, NLS will be testing the backflow devices of the single family homes. While performing the test, NLS will briefly turn on water to the backflow device for each home, test the backflow as required by the City of Corvallis, and ensure the irrigation system is re-winterized for each home.

#### SHRUB PRUNING

With the Landscape Committee's recommendation, the Board of Directors has modified the contract with Northwest Landscape Services so that most shrubs in single family home front yards and common areas will be pruned <u>just once per year.</u> This means that the shrubs will have a more natural look moving into the spring and summer.
