Yard Signs

Yard signs were again discussed by the Board. The CC&R (Amended and Restated Declaration of Protective Covenants, Conditions, Restrictions and Easements for Stoneybrook Village, dated October 5, 2011) paragraph 6.7, states that:

"Signs on any Lots shall be limited to 24 inches by 36 inches and are not to be displayed for more than 30 days. For Sale or Lease signs and Security Systemsigns are exempt from this provision."
