Preparedness Tip of the Month

Smoke detectors become unreliable after 8-10 years, even with good batteries, and thus have a 10-year expiration date. Most of ours are now expired. The Committee is in the process of doing thorough research on this matter and will prepare advice on acceptable types to purchase in order to be in compliance for a resalable home and the processes involved in replacement. The cost is generally not prohibitive. Watch for information on the next Preparedness Workshop October 13.

Major Irrigation Upgrade

Recently the Landscape Committee recommended a complete upgrade of the irrigation system in the parkway strips along a portion of 49th street, Country Club Drive, and Stoneybrook Street. After Board approval, and solicitation of bids, the work has begun. The old drip lines are all being removed and new sprinklers installed. The work will take a month or two for completion. Watch for a much improved landscape surrounding our Village.
