## **Preparedness Committee Tips**

Many of us travel in the summers, sometimes long distances. Here are a few ideas for supplies thatmayhelp keep you safe on these trips:

<u>Good Maps</u>- know where you are going. Don't trust only GPS. <u>Water</u>- you cannot have too much for drinking, washing or the radiator

<u>Crank radio/flashlight</u>- some can even charge your cell phone

LED Flashlight w/Extra Batteries- more convenient than the crank light

<u>Good First Aid Kit</u>- might save a life after an accident<u>Warning Triangle</u>- alerts other cars that you are in trouble ahead.

Jumper Cables- why wait for AAA when all you need is a jump? Work Gloves- changing tires, using jumper cables, etc. can be dirty work Light Rain Ponchos- its summer, but it's still Oregon Toilet Paper- for the emergency pause that refreshes Large Plastic Bags- have a multitude of potential uses Blanket- it can get cold, stranded on the side of the road. Tools-at least some basics: screw drivers, knife, pliers Personal- medications, bug repellant, sunblock, etc. Coast- when going to the Coast, watch for Tsunami Zones and escape routes.
