LANDSCAPE SERVICES. Here is the NLS activity list for November. Normal weekly activities like mowing, edging and weeding are also included.

November:

1. Concentrate primarily on leaf removal.
2. Shut off and drain all irrigation systems by Thanksgiving.
3. Mowing: one or two, as needed.
4. Continue spot spraying.

CLUBHOUSE POLICY. The Activities Committee has proposed revisions to the Clubhouse use policy. The Board requests community input on the proposed revisions. Carol Smedberg, a Certified American Red Cross Instructor, will give the course.
