**LANDSCAPE SERVICES.** Here is the NLS priority list for September. Not specified, but included are normal weekly activities like mowing, edging and weed spray.

Pre-dormant spray for horsetail, poison oak and blackberries  
Spot spray turf weeds  
Apply pre-emergent to beds as needed  
Aerate and overseed  
Monitor irrigation and decrease as needed

**RECYCLE AND WASTE CANS.** Recycle, yard debris and trash containers should be placed at the curb on your driveway or parking strip for pickup, not in the street. The street sweeper comes by on garbage days so this is particularly important, as you will not receive this service if any of your containers are in the street. The street sweeper will drive around them. This is also true for vehicles parked in the street on garbage day.
