No Parking Reminder: It is illegal to park in bike lanes. Birdsong Dr. has bike lanes, on both sides of the street in places, be especially careful to find a legal parking space when parking on Birdsong.

Pool Opened to Swimmers January 12th. The hours are from 6 AM to 8 PM. Users must gain access with the cardkey distributed by WCM and must accompany any guests they allow to use the pool or spa.

The pool will be closed briefly (1/2 day) sometime within the next two weeks while a new main breaker panel is installed in the mechanical room. A sign will be posted on the front door to alert users to the closure.

Swimmers and walkers-- we need your help. Volunteers are needed to perform a safety inspection of the pool area about every 2 hours. It is a very simple walk through and doesn't require any strength, just checking to be sure the pool and spa area appear safe, verifying the room temperature and water temperatures, and checking to see that doors and windows are properly locked to prevent unauthorized access. It shouldn't take longer than about 5 minutes. We are relying on our community members to help us in this effort to comply with State and County pool safety inspection requirements. Garden Notice: Gardeners were treated to an informative presentation by Darren Morgan from Shonnard's Nursery & Florist in December. He gave many helpful tips and left useful printouts to assist gardeners of all sorts. These will be placed in a binder in the Clubhouse. This binder will include photos and other interesting memorabilia.

All residents who wish to have a plot in the Community Garden may sign up on the bulletin board in the Clubhouse. We intend to assign spaces by March 1 so early crops may go in. Requests for particular spaces will be considered.

NOW is a good time, while soil is forgiving and roots are tender, to pull weeds before they become established! Last summer's gardeners should take a look at their spaces and tend them if needed.

There are two Allied Waste yard debris containers, provided by the Carpenter and Parks households, for you to place organic debris only (NO plastic, glass, metal, etc.) If you move one return it in the same position as you find it in the enclosure, please. Do not leave personal materials in the enclosure. About twenty wire plant supports which were unclaimed last fall are considered to be community property. Please share with neighbors!
