Jordan of TruGreen explained that as lawns mature they create a mixed blend of grasses and this is what the majority of homes in Corvallis have as their lawns. Under this standard, the use of chemicals to kill certain grass species is not used and costs are kept down and chemicals are not leached into our pond or the river.

**Vole Activity** – Please report any vole activity you see in your own yard or within Stoneybrook Village to WCM. Quick treatment will help prevent spread of the problem.

**Street Lights Out** – If a street light is out or flickering, you may report it by contacting Pacific Power at 1-877-548-3768 or 1-888-221-7070. Power outages may also be reported at either of these numbers.
